## Bus Stop Safety

Important behaviors at the bus stop:
Arrive 5 minutes before bus is scheduled

- Go back home for help if you miss bus
- Have all items in book bag before leaving home
- Wait in safe place, 12 feet away from traffic



## More Bus Stop Safety

Never speak to strangers
Respect property of others
Keep noise down while waiting

Stay away from road No horseplay, pushing or shoving
Form a "single file" line 12 feet away from road


Use no electronics when boarding

A blowing bus horn means danger. Look \& find safety.

## Unloading at School

Important behaviors when unloading at school:

- Make sure no items get caught in handrail or door

Exit danger zone \& get bus driver's attention

- Something left behind on bus
- Something dropped near bus



## More Unloading at School

Remain seated until bus is stopped and door is opened
Do not push or shove, but wait your turn to get off Have all belongings inside book bag
Use handrail for safety Walk (don't run) straight towards school


## Loading at School

## Important behaviors when loading at school:

- Have all belongings inside book bag before leaving classroom
- Dropped items are a danger
Never chase after a moving bus
- Better to miss bus and be safe!



# More Loading at School 

Walk slowly towards bus. Never run.
Walk straight towards bus door

- Be sure bus driver can see you

Stay away from front and rear bus tires and board bus promptly Load in an orderly manner

If you get on wrong bus by mistake, tell bus driver


## More Loading at School (2)

Use handrail for safety
Go directly to seat
Never place head, arms or any object out of bus window


## Riding Safely

## Important behaviors when riding the bus

Sit the safe way:

- Facing forward
- Back against seat back
- Bottom against seat bottom
- Fully within the seat space



## More Riding Safely (1)

Follow bus driver's directions the $1^{\text {st }}$ time
Always go directly to seat When on the bus, remain seated
Always sit forwards with your back against the seat Tell bus driver if someone is picking on you


Keep aisles and exits clears at all times

## More Riding Safely (2)

Respect others and their property
Be quiet enough to not distract driver
Don't eat, drink, or chew gum on bus
Don't throw any objects
Don't stick any body part out of bus window
Don't bring or use tobacco, drugs, or weapons on bus

## More Riding Safely (3)

Don't bring animals or glass objects on bus
Don't use obscene gestures and/or language
Don't use cell phones on bus or when exiting
Never use electronic device or wear headphones/ear buds when exiting
Only get off of bus at your stop Keep bus clean

## Emergency Evacuation

When might you evacuate?

- Accident
- Fire

Emergency where you need to leave bus quickly
There are 3 ways to evacuate the bus

- Front door
- Rear door

Front and rear door


## ore Emergency Evacuation

Buses also have
Roof hatches
Emergency windows
In all types of evacuation:
Listen to bus driver's instructions

- Remain calm
- Remain quiet


Stay seated until it is your turn to leave

- Unload letting seats take turns


## ore Emergency Evacuation

In all types of evacuation (Continued):

- Leave books, lunch boxes, and other belongings on bus
- Walk as you leave the bus. Do not run.
- Go 100 feet (3 bus lengths) away from bus
- Remain in an orderly group

Wait for further instruction from bus driver or student helper
