Make-up Work

excused absences

- You have 5 days to make-up the work missed.
- If you do not make-up the work, the assignments will remain a 0(F).
- It is your responsibility to ask for the work missed.

No running, pushing, or shoving.

- Walk to and from classes and at recess.



Main building

- When entering the building between classes, students must **walk to the right**.
- Do not walk through the benches.
- Students will be assigned a pew to space out for teachers.

Students going to Ms. E. Plaisance, Mr. Curole, or to Mr. Robichaux

- 7th graders---will enter at the doors closest to the main building. Enter your **right**.
- 7th graders---exit on your **left** and out the doors closest nearest the main building.

Students going to Ms. Perez, Ms. Sanders or Ms. Champagne

- Enter to the **right** through the doors at the **back** of the 7th grade building. These are near portables.
- Exit to the **left** out the doors closest to the portables.

7th grade building-when return to normal

- Enter the building ONLY through the doors nearest the main building.
- Exit only through the back of the 7th grade building or nearest the portables.

Cell Phones

- Only use your cell phone in green zones only.
 - Commons area
 - Bus area
 - Must be off and in your school bag during class.
 - Do not take pictures or video anyone without their permission. You may end up with consequences.

using the device in a red zone

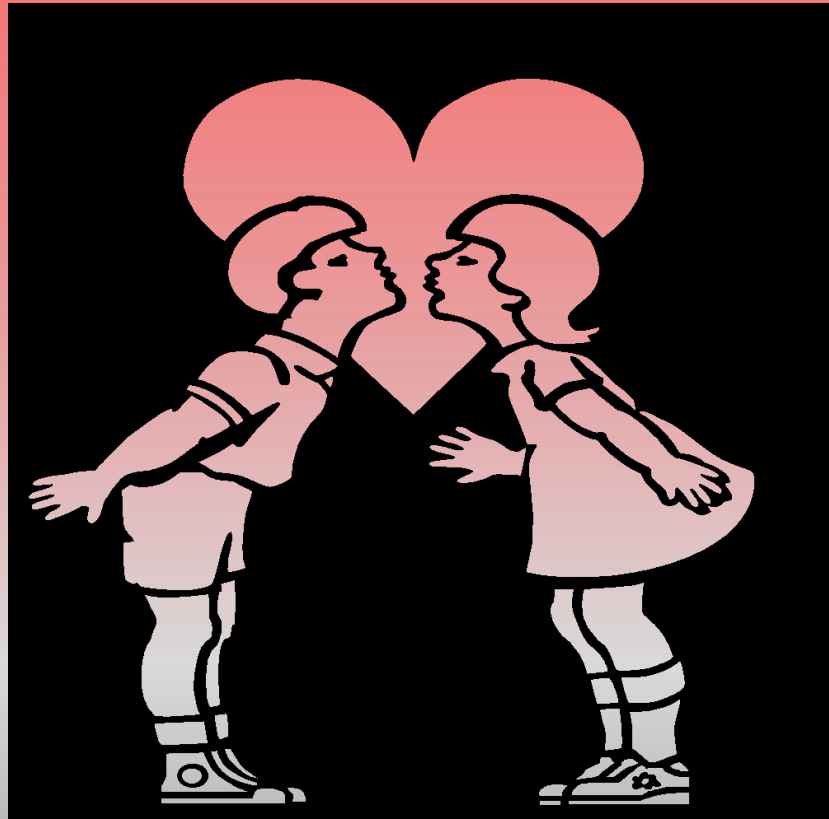
1st Offense – Documented Warning, recess detention, confiscate device. Required for parent to pick it up.

2nd Offense – Office Referral and 1 day ISS, confiscate device. Required for parent to pick it up.

3rd Offense – Office Referral and 2 days ISS, confiscate device. Required for parent to pick it up.

4th Offense- Office Referral and 2 days ISS with loss of cell phone privileges

- This means: a fine, court and community service after school.

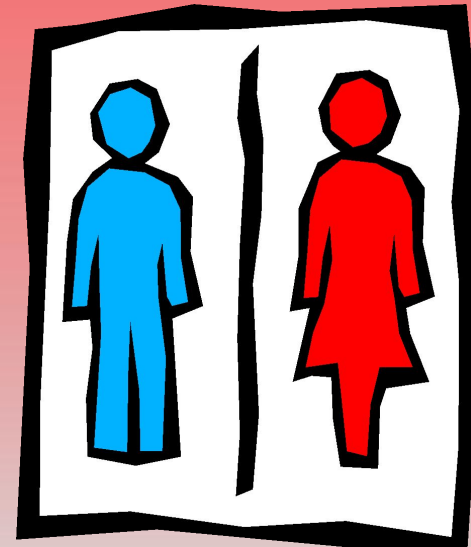
Show respect for yourself, others, and property
